REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO TAKE DMV PA ROAD TEST

1. Valid Permit
2. License of the person bringing you. (They MUST be 21 years or older)
3. Valid Insurance card for car you will be using for your test
4. Valid Registration Card for car you will be using for your test
5. Last 4 digits of your Social Security Number
6. If under 18, Form DL-180C (65-hour parent / guardian certification form)

**** DL-180C 65 Hr. certification form must be notarized if parent does not come in ****

DMV WILL NOT ACCEPT PHOTO COPIES OR FAXES

The DMV provides you with the following information with the intention that you will be aware of their expectations and your driving test will be a memorable one.

Knowledge of Controls

You are tested on your ability to operate all the controls of your vehicle; turn signals, parking lights, headlights (high and low beams), horn, wipers, window defrosters (front and rear), four-way flashers, parking / emergency brake and foot brake lights. All controls must work or you will not be allowed to take your driver's test.

Please make sure you can locate and operate all of these controls.

Skill Maneuvers

Parallel Park in an (8' X 24') stall without striking cones, markers, or jumping over the curb.

Road Test

Be able to operate your vehicle through traffic, roadways, and intersection, all in a safe and professional manner as per Publication 95. (Drivers Manual) If you have any questions about your driving test, Please ask the Examiner before you start the test.

Note: If it rains or snows, headlights must be turned on when windshield wipers are in use.
